

More support for Hand Counting!

Paper hand counting resolution from RNC

The Republican National Committee unanimously (168 members) passed this
resolution on August 26th, 2023 titled "Return to Excellence" in American voting
and elections. It consist of twenty one bullet points, below are just two of them

"The grassroots activist of the republican party have discovered and made it abundantly clear there are recognized problems with electronic election procedures and intentional complications of instituted systems that complicate, belabor and slow down our election processes".

"The Republican National Committee supports the rights of counties and states that are willing and able to competently and efficiently implement voting procedures that do not require the use of machines and those that implement hand counting procedures that are fully auditable".

A conventional paper ballot or hand count election is not a radical solution to our elections.

Over 24 Nations hold hand-count elections, including larger nations like

Argentina, Australia, Canada, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Japan, Malaysia, the Netherlands,

Norway, Russia, Spain, Sweden, and the United Kingdom.

President Trumps Executive Order on Election Integrity March 25th 2025

Sec. 4 Includes language that states that "the amended Federal Voluntary Voting System Guidelines and other guidance shall provide voting systems that should not use a ballot in which a vote is contained within a barcode or quick-response code (QR Code) in the vote counting process"

This language means that this September all voting machines that mark a ballot for the voter will no longer be Federally certified, that accounts for 40 counties. Keep in mind that the remaining counties, hand marking the ballots are still vulnerable since they also place their hand marked ballot into another proprietary black box "optical scanner" that does not allow for full transparency.
